Authors are suggested carefully reading the Scopes of these two journals before submitting manuscripts to either of the above two journals.

Please note that all manuscripts will be subjected to the mandatory selection process for the journal selected, including the strict peer review procedure, therefore, acceptance for presentation at the meeting is not a guarantee for publication in the journals.
